

# Does your child live with Vision Impairment?

The Australian Childhood Vision Impairment Register collects information on children living with vision impairment. This information is used in research and to plan better services throughout Australia. Information from the Register is shared with researchers and planners, however children & their family are not identified in any way.

The Australian Childhood Vision Impairment Register is maintained by the Royal Institute for Deaf and Blind Children, a service provider with a 150 year history of supporting children with vision impairment and their families.

If your child is living with vision impairment you are invited to join.

By registering your child you will contribute to what is known about children who live with vision impairment and what best meets their needs. The Australian Childhood Vision Impairment Register can also help you with information to support your child's health, education and social development. This includes helping to find information on the specialized services your child might find useful now or may need in their future.
