RIDBC Thomas Pattison School was established in 1993. It provides a quality bilingual educational program for deaf students who use Auslan (Australian Sign Language) and English in its spoken and written form. Students follow the regular NSW Board of Studies Curriculum.

### Features:

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- Primary focus on Auslan and English language development.
- Group and/or individual Speech Pathology for all students
- Mainstream inclusion/integration programs for all students
- Real-time captioning in some classes
- Parent Auslan and deafness related classes
- Vocational skills program
- Host Family program for students who reside outside the Sydney metropolitan area (for students 11 years+)
- Video-conferencing facilities for remote students
- Audiologist



## Who can apply for enrolment?

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The school offers classes from kindergarten to Year 10, 4½–16 years, who have a hearing loss of 60 dB or greater in the better ear.
