RIDBC provides education, therapy, audiology and cochlear implant services for adults and children with hearing or vision loss, and their families.

Services include:

- Transdisciplinary early intervention programs for children aged from birth to 8 years, including;
 - Intensive regular individual & group sessions
 - Parent education programs
 - Range of communication options
 - Braille tuition and vision loss support
 - Transition to preschool and school
- School support;
- Programs for children with unilateral and mild hearing loss;
- Vision and hearing assessment services;
- Therapy and diagnostic services;
- SCIC Cochlear Implant Program: assessment, surgical coordination, mapping and rehabilitation;
- Co-location with Canberra ENT surgeons.

RIDBC's highly qualified and experienced team of teachers, audiologists, speech pathologists, surgeons, orthoptists, occupational therapists, psychologists, physiotherapists and technology consultants work together to collaborate with families and tailor an individual program for each child.

Who is eligible for RIDBC services?

RIDBC Canberra services are available to:

- Children with significant vision or hearing loss;
- Adults with significant vision or hearing loss;
- No formal referral is required but documentation of the sensory impairment is necessary before services can be provided.

Interpretation/translation services are available for people from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) backgrounds.
