RIDBC Jim Patrick Audiology Centre at North Rocks is a family-friendly audiology clinic offering a full range of children's audiological services. The Centre incorporates the latest technology for hearing assessment of children from birth onwards.

Services include:

- Behavioural testing for all ages
- Electrophysiological studies including:
 - Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR) testing
 - Otoacoustic Emissions testing
 - Acoustic Impedance testing
- Speech perception testing

What happens during an assessment?

Our tests are performed in a sound booth, designed to be child-friendly with the use of toys in a play-like environment. For children under 3 years of age, or who have special needs, two highly-trained audiological staff work together.
