RIDBC Matilda Rose Centre provides an environment in which children with hearing impairment, including those with additional needs, and their families, receive specialised, integrated and intensive programs to optimise listening, relating and communicating.

The Centre is staffed by an experienced transdisciplinary team including special educators, speech and language pathologists, audiologists, an occupational therapist and physiotherapist.

Services include:

- One-on-one, individualised sessions in collaboration with parents/care-givers
- Small, structured group sessions
- Preparation, transition and support to preschool, school or other educational placements
- SCIC Cochlear Implant Program
- Parent education
- Ongoing comprehensive assessment of each child and family's needs. This includes audiology, orthoptics, speech, language and occupational therapy and physiotherapy.
