RIDBC provides education and therapy services to children with hearing or vision loss throughout Australia. The highly qualified and experienced RIDBC staff develop and implement individual programs collaboratively with each child's family. Children may also benefit from additional support provided by a full multidisciplinary team. Services are delivered face-to-face and/or by videoconference.

Services at RIDBC Darwin include:

- One-on-one individualised sessions in collaboration with parents/caregivers
- Group parent education sessions
- Small, structured group sessions
- Information about hearing and/or vision loss
- Listening and Spoken Language development
- Auslan support if needed
- Parent networking and information
- A lending library with child and parent resources
- Transition to school and School Support
- Visits to RIDBC's Sydney Campus, including:
 - early learning groups
 - preschool/school visits
 - assessments and planning
 - face-to-face sessions
 - on-site accommodation



Who can apply for enrolment?

RIDBC Darwin services are available to any child in Australia who:

- Has a significant hearing impairment and/or a significant vision impairment
- Is between the ages of 0–18
- Has not yet left school

No formal referral is required but documentation of the child's sensory impairment is necessary before entry to the program.
