# RIDBC Western Sydney Services

RIDBC is a registered provider with the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

We can support you to access and navigate the NDIS to ensure you can receive the supports and services you need.

You will have access to a team of professionals who specialise in vision or hearing loss. All of our services are integrated and tailored to your individual needs.





## Early learning services

We provide family-centred education and therapy services for children with a hearing impairment. These services can be integrated with our preschool in Glenmore Park.



## Family counsellor (social work)

Our team includes social workers who can support you and your family to access our services and help you throughout the entire journey.



## Speech pathology assessment and support

We can provide assessments and ongoing therapy through our qualified team of speech pathologists.



## Cochlear implant services

We offer a comprehensive cochlear implant program for children and adults of all ages - from initial hearing loss assessment, through to implantation and ongoing lifetime support.



## Audiology services

We provide a full range of audiology services for cochlear implant users and some diagnostic services to both children and adults.
